Council Tax Summary 2018/19

Following extensive consultation and after considering the levels of Central Government funding for 2018/19, Ron Hogg, the Police, Crime and Victims' Commissioner, agreed his budget and set the precept (police element of the Council Tax) on 19th February 2018.

The following table indicates what the Council Tax increase will mean for households in County Durham and Darlington:
